Join the System Improvement Leads (SIL) and Key2Ed, a national authority on IEP facilitation and conflict resolution, to learn skills and strategies that allow you to prevent and/or work through conflict during the IEP process.

Work collaboratively to develop skills, knowledge and mindset for:

- · Assist people in building understanding and agreement
- Prevent, reduce, and resolve conflict
