Questions to consider Please note that any questions you have are good questions and you are encouraged to take them to your child's teacher.
 There may be other educators I want to check in with. Will you help me facilitate those connections? Will you provide me with contact info for the other educators working with my child? How can I assist my student during distance learning? What information can I provide you to help you better monitor progress? When can we talk to check in? Let's set up a day and time each week. Do you have any resources for activities I can do with my child to support their learning and working on IEP goals? I'm feeling overwhelmed or frustrated. Can we talk and make a plan? Can I contact you with a question if I don't understand an assignment?
